Notes:

Family membership includes Ordinary/Life membership for one adult and 'free' junior memberships for their children, and/or children for whom they are legally responsible, between the ages of 8 and 18. Those under 18 must be under appropriate adult or family supervision at all times.

Student members are aged 18 to 21 years in 1st April 2011, they must be in full-time education or training.

Junior members must be under 18 on 1st April 2011. Junior members are entitled to use club equipment and facilities when under the direction/coaching of an appropriate Full member of the club.

Country members shall be those ordinary members who have paid at least one ordinary subscription, and who reside outwith a distance of 40miles from the club house by the most practical means of transport, and who do not reside locally for more than one month during the boating season (April to October).

Associate members shall be at least 21 years of age on admission; they are essentially social members, who do not participate in watersports at the Club or in the management of the Club. Associate members are not entitled to use the Club boats nor keep a boat on the foreshore or in the Club premises.
